Aggression - try to understand the reason for verbal or physical signs of aggression.

- Think about what happened before the behavior. Can you identify what triggered the behavior?
- We are emotional creatures and this does not change with Alzheimer’s disease, but the patient may have difficulty expressing their emotions. Look for feelings behind the event or words being said.
- Speak slowly and in a soft tone. Don’t get angry!
- Can the environment be adapted to reduce the behavior?
- Soothe the patient – music, massage or exercise can be helpful.
- Change the situation – trying something different might reduce the behavior.

Anxiety or agitation – restlessness and the need to move around can be signs.

- Can you identify the reason for the anxiety?
- Reassure the patient that you are there, they are safe – use calming words and voice.
- Is the patient bored? Utilize activities, hobbies, art, music, a walk to help provide an avenue for your patient to relax or be engaged.
- Can the environment be changed to reduce noise or distractions?
