One-stop resource center for seniors to break ground in Viera

One Senior Place LLC of Melbourne announced today the plans for a new-concept business community designed for senior care and services

According to OSP President Don Kramer, the 18,000-square-foot facility located in Viera is the first business community of its kind and includes an executive office building, a senior resource library and a themed "elder services only" shopping mall all under one roof.

Kramer emphasizes that the facility is not another medical building.

"We're not just building office space -- we're creating a needed resource for seniors and their families," says Kramer. "One Senior Place will be home to a comprehensive cross-section of the area's finest senior care providers, carefully selected from a long list of key business categories in order to create a mix that best benefits the consumer."

Kramer explains that this will include businesses such as home care agencies, physical therapists, medical equipment suppliers, professional elder care managers, community and nonprofit resources, elder law attorneys, senior financial planners, travel agents and more.

The idea, he says, is to help seniors and their family members have an "all-inclusive resource to gather information, receive guidance and access a full range of providers focused on senior care and services -- both on-site and through a comprehensive referral network."

Scheduled to open in the summer of 2005, One Senior Place will hold its groundbreaking ceremony on Dec. 8 at 8085 Spyglass Hill Road, Viera.
